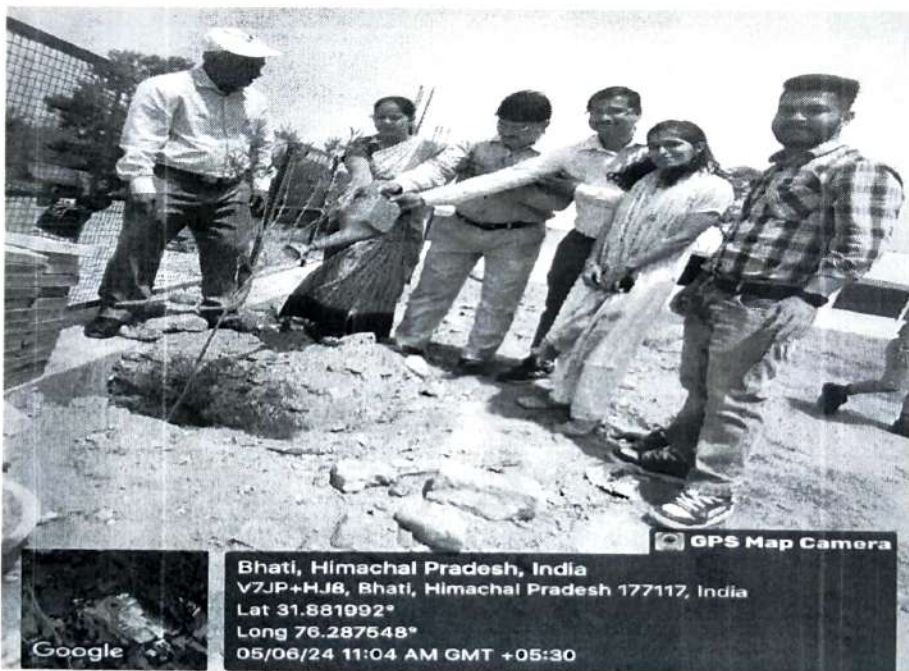

Every year on June 5th, we mark World Environment Day to raise awareness of the pressing environmental issues of our day. The themes of World Environment Day 2024 are restoring land, halting desertification, and enhancing drought resistance. The largest worldwide environmental day is World Environment Day. Under the direction of the UN Environment Programme, it has been held yearly since 1973 and has developed into the biggest worldwide environmental outreach event. Ecosystems are under attack everywhere in the world. The natural areas that are essential to human survival, such as farms, lakes, dry lands, and woods, are nearing their limit. As a crucial carbon sink, land "plays a key role in the climate system" because its surfaces, like forests, control the planet's temperature and aid in the storage of carbon. Approximately thirty percent of the carbon emissions produced by human activities, such as the burning of fossil fuels, were absorbed by land-based ecosystems in the last ten years alone. But the ability of our land to sustain food production, preserve freshwater and forest resources, control the climate and air quality, and sustain agricultural expansion is being undermined by deforestation, urbanization, industrial development, and unsustainable farming practices. Additionally, as the earth warms, more frequent and intense extreme weather events such as droughts and deserts occur, exacerbating the already severe land degradation caused by changing climate. On June 5, 2024, the ECO CLUB at the Laureate Institute of Pharmacy observed World Environment Day with the topic "Land Restoration, Desertification, and Drought Resilience." Laureate Institute of Pharmacy aspires to enable its students to become outspoken supporters of environmental conservation by serving as an example of environmentally conscious behavior. Eco-Clubs, which are campus programs devoted to green projects, are an excellent way to get students started on a meaningful road toward environmental protection. Each member or student of Laureate Global School Kathog is greeted by Director/Principal Dr. M.S. Ashawat, who also explains the topic and how we conserve the environment. This event featured a number of structured activities. Our Chief Guest, Dr. Ran Singh, gave advice on how to save energy, preserve land, save water, avoid setting fire to woods, and reuse air conditioner water for planting.
